

Monroe Manor Nursing Home Nursing Scholarships

Monroe Manor Nursing Home in Paris, Missouri is fortunate to be able to offer two nursing scholarship funds. The program offers \$750 per year for students enrolled in a state accredited school of nursing. This scholarship is used to assist current staff members to become licensed nurses and is renewable for each year of continuing education. The other scholarship offers \$750 per recruitment for graduates of an accredited school of nursing and will be pursuing to further their education in nursing.

Qualifications for the \$750 scholarship per year for students enrolled in an accredited school of nursing:

- 1. Be an employee of Monroe Manor Nursing Home for at least six months and be in good standing with a 95% attendance over the last six months.
- 2. Be able to show proof of acceptance to an accredited school of nursing.
- 3. Maintain satisfactory academic status (not on academic probation).
- 4. Letter from recipient stating reason for pursuing a career in nursing.

Obligations of recipient:

1. For each year the recipient receives a scholarship, it is required that the recipient will work for six months after graduation for Monroe Manor Nursing Home. If for any reason the recipient cannot meet this obligation, the scholarship will then be considered a loan and the student must make arrangements to begin payments back to the scholarship fund within 60 days. The period of pay back cannot exceed 24 months.

For applications to *continue* a scholarship that has been granted for the previous year applications should include: Application (obtain from Business Office Manager), transcript of most recent year of education and name two references who may be contacted if needed.

Qualifications for the \$750 recruitment scholarship for graduates of accredited school of nursing and will be pursuing to further their education in nursing:

- 1. Transcript of most recent year of graduation.
- 2. Two letters of reference regarding character and potential success in nursing.
- 3. Letter from recipient stating reason for pursuing a career in geriatric nursing.

Obligations of recipient:

For each year the recipient receives a scholarship it is required that the recipient will work for six months
after graduation for Monroe Manor Nursing Home. If for any reason the recipient cannot meet this
obligation, the scholarship will then be considered a loan and the student must make arrangements to begin
payments back to the scholarship fund within 60 days of graduation. The period of pay back cannot exceed
30 months.

Recruitment scholarship agreement

Monroe Manor Nursing Home scholarship program offers a \$750 per recruitment scholarship for graduates of accredited schools of nursing. This is available only as scholarship funds are available.

The check will be made payable to the student and the school upon evidence of acceptance and enrollment in the program.

The following are obligations of recipient:

- 1. For each year the recipient receives a scholarship it is required that the recipient will work for 6 months after graduation for Monroe Manor Nursing Home.
- 2. If for any reason the recipient cannot meet this obligation, the scholarship will then be considered a loan and the student must make arrangements to begin payments back to the scholarship fund within 60 days of graduation. The period of pay back cannot exceed thirty months.
- 3. Student will apply for the scholarship program once in each calendar year and must show satisfactory grades for continued eligibility.

I acknowledge that if I do not successfully complete the program and work the required time I will begin payments according to a schedule mutually agreed upon by the administration of Monroe Manor Nursing Home and myself.
